**One and a Half Wife** - Meghna Pant 2023-08-08

Amara Malhotra was fourteen years old when her parents immigrated to the United States of America. But unlike most Indian immigrants, she was not destined to achieve the American Dream. Much to the anxiety of her parents—the spirited Biji and the doting Baba—Amara leads an unremarkable life. That is, until she marries Harvard-educated millionaire, Prashant Roy. This fairy tale isn't meant to last, though, and even as Amara's marriage collapses, she finds herself returning to the land of her birth, to the small city of Shimla. Here, in a borough grappling with questions of modernity, Amara is caught in a tug-of-war between old beliefs and new ones, between parents who favour obedience and new friends who encourage independent thought. With powerful insights, *One and a Half Wife* traces the coming-of-age of multiple characters, while redefining family, relationships and love in contemporary India.

**Sacred Geography of Goddesses in South Asia** - Rana P. B. Singh 2010

This book consists of thirteen essays that deal with links between ecology and shamanism, landscape and nature spirit, emphasising web of meanings imbued in the cultural tradition of portraying landscape as temple and territory as archetypal representation of the cosmos. In view of appreciating the path in this direction paved by David Kinsley, this anthology is a memorial tribute to him by his students, friends, associates and admirers, including an essay that critically and rationally examined his contributions and their relevance today. Of course, there are books on the thematic or disciplinary-packed orientation, however rarely any interdisciplinary book that narrates many perspectives and facets around sacred geography of goddesses is published. This anthology fulfils that gap substantially, through the essays by scholars from religious studies, geography, anthropology and cultural studies. The themes covered include: sacred places, spatiality and symbolism; mental journeys and cosmic topography, illustrated with Sricakra and Sricakrapuja; pilgrimage sites in the Siwalik Region where landscape has played special role to awaken human mind; Pavagadh, where landscape helps to make the power of the Mother Goddess; spatial circulation in ritualscape of the matrikas in Kathmandu Valley; scenario at the Kamakhya Pitha; sacredscape and spatial structure of be-headed goddess at Rajarappa; sacred geography and formation of Vindhyaachal goddess territory; Hindu Goddesses in Kashi: Spatial Patterns and Symbolic Orders; the ten Mahavidyasâ (TM) Yatra in making the goddess spirit invoked; role of Durga in the present sacredscape of Varanasi; issue of images and performances related to the river goddess Ganga; and Green Tara in the wall paintings of Alchi.

*Educational Attainment and Timing of Childbearing Among Recent Cohorts of Canadian Women [microform]* - Margaret De Wit 1993

This research examines factors associated with the timing and risk of first and second births in Canada, focusing primarily on the role of women's educational attainment. A major theme is that fundamental changes in recent years, not only in the duration of education, but also in the content and social significance of formal schooling, have resulted in changes in the strength and nature of the basic association across successive birth cohorts of women. The Accelerated Failure Time Model (AFT) is applied to data from the 1984 Canadian Fertility Survey (CFS) in order to determine how educational attainment, estimated as closely as possible to the dates of both first and second births, influences the timing of childbearing and whether the importance of this variable varies according to birth cohorts. Two parallel multivariate models are estimated, measuring women's education with both four and three categories or levels, in order to examine possible changes over time in the significance of certain thresholds of attainment. The results suggest that, among a number of variables useful for distinguishing different levels of risk, educational attainment is an important predictor of birth timing. Its effects, however, are largely dependent on birth order and also on membership in a particular birth cohort to some extent. Patterns of

influence also differ between the models using education with three and four categories, indicating shifts over time in the significance for fertility behavior of a given duration (or quantity) of formal schooling. In general, higher education is seen to exert a positive or delaying influence on birth timing (or a reduction in risk) for women of most age groups and birth orders, although its statistical significance is confined mostly to predicting the first birth event. As expected, certain cohort variations are also evident, most notably in the case of first birth, where the overall pattern appears to involve a relative increase across cohorts in the delaying or decelerating effect of higher educational attainment on birth timing. This general trend may be interpreted as resulting from changes in the content and socioeconomic significance of formal schooling over the past few decades which have worked to increase the delaying impact of educational achievement on women's timing of births. Implications of the findings for policy and research are discussed.

Son of a famous father. Father of a famous son. I am the hyphen between them. Only, Rishi Kapoor was and is so much more. Few actors in Hindi cinema have had this sort of a career arc: from the gawky adolescent pining for his schoolteacher (*Mera Naam Joker*, 1970) to the naughty ninety-year-old (*Kapoor & Sons*, 2016), Rishi Kapoor has regaled audiences for close to fifty years. He won a National Award for his debut, became an overnight sensation with his first film as a leading man (*Bobby*, 1973), and carved a niche for himself with a string of romantic musical blockbusters in an era known for its angst-ridden films. He was the youth icon that is still the toast of the satellite TV circuit. The songs he lip-synced are the bread and butter of all radio stations even today. Then there was the second coming after a brief hiatus in the 1990s - as one of the finest actors in mainstream Hindi cinema with powerhouse performances in films like *Do Dooni Chaar*, *D-Day*, *Agneepath* and others. Characteristically candid, Rishi Kapoor brings Punjabi brio to the writing of *Khullam Khulla*. This is as up close and personal a biography as any fan could have hoped for. He writes about growing up in the shadow of a legendary father, skipping school to act in *Mera Naam Joker*, the workings of the musical hits of the era, an encounter with Dawood Ibrahim, his heroines (their working relationship, the gossip and the frisson that was sometimes real), his approach to his craft, his tryst with clinical depression, and more. **The Kama Sutra of Vatsyayana** - Vatsyayana 2018-09-27  
The Kama Sutra is an ancient Indian Hindu text widely considered to be the standard work on human sexual behavior in Sanskrit literature written by Vatsyayana. A portion of the work consists of practical advice on sexual intercourse. It is largely in prose, with many inserted anustubh poetry verses. "Kama" which is one of the four goals of Hindu life, means desire including sexual desire the latter being the subject of the textbook, and "sutra" literally means a thread or line that holds things together, and more metaphorically refers to an aphorism (or line, rule, formula), or a collection of such aphorisms in the form of a manual. Contrary to popular perception, especially in the western world, Kama sutra is not exclusively a sex manual; it presents itself as a guide to a virtuous and gracious living that discusses the nature of love, family life and other aspects pertaining to pleasure oriented faculties of human life. Kama Sutra, in parts of the world, is presumed or depicted as a synonym for creative sexual positions; in reality, only 20% of Kama Sutra is about sexual positions. The majority of the book, notes Jacob Levy, is about the philosophy and theory of love, what triggers desire, what sustains it, how and when it is good or bad. The Kama Sutra is the oldest and most notable of a group of texts known generically as Kama Shastra. Historians attribute Kamasutra to be composed between 400 BCE and 200 CE. John Keay says that the Kama Sutra is a compendium that was collected into its present form in the 2nd century CE. Includes unique illustrations!

**50 Films That Changed Bollywood, 1995-2015** - Shubhra Gupta 2016-12-10

Hindi cinema was trapped in formulaic cliches for decades: lost-and-found themes, sacrificing mothers, brothers on opposite sides of the law, villains lording over their dens, colourful molls, six songs, the use of rape as a plot pivot, and cops who always arrived too late. It hit an all-time low in the 1980s. Then, in 1991, came liberalization, and a wave of openness and aspiration swept across urban India. *Dilwale Dulhania Le Jayenge* was released in 1995 - and Hindi cinema became Bollywood. A new crop of film-makers began to challenge and break away from established rules. Over the next twenty years, a number of Hindi films consistently pushed the envelope in terms of content and technique to create a new kind of cinema. Among other innovations, film-makers came up with ways of crowd funding a film (*Ankhon Dekhi*), did away with songs if the narrative did not need them (*Gangaajal*), addressed different sexual preferences (*My Brother ... Nikhil*) and people with special needs (*Black*) like no one had ever done before. As film critic with the *Indian Express*, Shubhra Gupta has stayed the course these twenty years and more and experienced the transition first-hand. In *50 Films That Changed Bollywood, 1995-2015*, she looks at the modern classics that have redefined Hindi cinema - from *DDLJ* and *Rangeela* to *Satya* and *Dev D* to *Queen* and *Bajrangi Bhaijaan*. Gupta offers a fascinating glimpse into how these films spoke to their viewers and how the viewers reacted to them - and, ultimately, how they changed us and how we changed them.
