This edition has some structural changes, primarily made to adapt the analysis of European tax integration to the application of the EU Charter on Fundamental Rights in tax matters and the development of global tax competition. The latter phenomenon is being targeted by the BEPS and Tax Transparency projects in a supranational framework that coordinates the exercise of national taxing rights around the globe and which also has significant repercussions for European tax integration.
