EXAMINING MARGARET ATWOOD'S WORK IN THE CONTEXT OF THE COMPLEX HISTORY OF THE BILDUNGSROMAN, ELLEN McWILLIAMS EXPLORES HOW THE GENRE HAS BEEN APPROPRIATED BY WOMEN WRITERS IN THE SECOND HALF OF THE TWENTIETH CENTURY. SHE DEMONSTRATES THAT

TORONTO, McWILLIAMS UNCOVERS INFLUENCES THAT SHAPED ATWOOD'S FASHIONING OF IDENTITY IN HER EARLY NOVELS, PAYING PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO ATWOOD'S PREOCCUPATION WITH SURVIVAL AS A KEY SYMBOL OF CANADIAN LITERATURE, CULTURE, AND IDENTITY. SHE ALSO CONSIDERS THE GENRE'S AFTERLIFE ON DISPLAY IN CAT'S EYE, THE ROBBER BRIDE, ALIAS GRACE, THE BLIND ASSASSIN, AND MORAL DISORDER, IN WHICH THE FORMULATIONS OF SELFHOOD AND IDENTITY IN ATWOOD'S EARLY FICTION ARE REVISITED AND DEVELOPED. ATWOOD EMERGES AS A WRITER WHO SELF-CONSCIOUSLY INVOKES AND THEN UNDERCUTS THE TRADITIONS OF THE BILDUNGSROMAN, A TURN THAT MAY BE READ AS A MEANS OF AT ONCE INTERROGATING AND PERPETUATING THE FORM. McWILLIAMS'S BOOK FURTHERS OUR UNDERSTANDING OF SUBJECTIVITY IN ATWOOD'S FICTION AND CONTRIBUTES TO ONGOING CONVERSATIONS ABOUT THE ROLE GENDER AND CULTURAL CONTEXTS PLAY IN REFRAMING GENERIC BOUNDARIES.

THE INDIVIDUAL CHAPTERS ARE ORGANIZED CHRONOLOGICALLY, WITH EACH SUBDIVIDED INTO SEVEN CATEGORIES: ATWOOD'S WORKS, ADAPTATIONS, QUOTATIONS, INTERVIEWS, SCHOLARLY RESOURCES, REVIEWS OF ATWOOD'S WORKS, AND REVIEWS OF ADAPTATIONS OF ATWOOD'S WORKS. THE BOOK ALSO INCLUDES A CHAPTER ENTITLED 'ATWOOD ON THE WEB,' AS WELL AS EXTENSIVE AUTHOR AND SUBJECT INDEXES. MUCH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE LITERATURE HAS CALLED ATTENTION TO THE FACT THAT WOMEN'S MATERIAL NEEDS FOR SHELTER, DAYCARE, EMPLOYMENT, AND LEGAL

PROTECTION MAY RENDER THEM HELPLESS TO LEAVE TOXIC RELATIONSHIPS. YET, EVEN WITH THE PROVISION OF THESE, MANY WOMEN REMAIN TIGHTLY WOUND IN THEIR ABUSERS' EMBRACE. IN CUPID'S KNIFE: WOMEN'S ANGER AND AGENCY IN VIOLENT RELATIONSHIPS, ABBY STEIN DRAWS ON THE GRIPPING NARRATIVES OF PHYSICALLY AND EMOTIONALLY ABUSED WOMEN TO ILLUMINATE HOW SPLITTING OFF THEIR OWN AGGRESSION UNDERMINES WOMEN'S AGENCY, MAKING IT ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE FOR THEM TO LEAVE VIOLENT PARTNERS. PSYCHOLOGY, WITH ITS FOCUS ON 'MANAGING' MEN'S ANGER IN VIOLENT RELATIONSHIPS, HAS HAD LITTLE TO OFFER IN THE WAY OF SUBSTANTIVE CRITICAL WORK WITH WOMEN ON THE IDENTIFICATION, INTEGRATION AND CONSTRUCTIVE USE OF A RANGE OF DARKER EMOTIONS TYPICALLY LABELLED AS ANTITHETICAL TO THE NORMS FOR FEMALE BEHAVIOUR. IN THIS BOOK, ABBY STEIN SHOWS THAT ALTHOUGH A NUMBER OF PSYCHOLOGICAL PROCESSES THAT CONTRIBUTE TO THE INTRACTABILITY OF ABUSIVE RELATIONSHIPS HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED - SUCH AS TRAUMA BONDING AND LEARNED HELPLESSNESS - THEIR RECOGNITION HAS OFFERED NO CLINICAL PATHWAY OUT OF THE ABYSS. STEIN SUGGESTS THAT OUR ATTENTION TO OTHER ASPECTS OF THE INTERNAL WORLD, THE RELATIONAL FRAMEWORK, AND THE CULTURAL CONTEXT IN WHICH BOTH OPERATE, MAY BE MORE USEFUL THAN CURRENT INTERVENTIONS IN DETERMINING INDIVIDUAL TREATMENTS THAT BREAK THE OFT-CITED 'CYCLE OF VIOLENCE'. MORE GLOBALLY,

CUPID'S KNIFE: WOMEN'S ANGER AND AGENCY IN VIOLENT RELATIONSHIPS JUMPSTARTS A PROVOCATIVE CONVERSATION ABOUT HOW FEMALE AGGRESSION CAN BE REPURPOSED AS A CATALYST FOR SOCIAL CHANGE. IT WILL BE ESSENTIAL READING FOR PSYCHOANALYSTS, PSYCHOLOGISTS, PSYCHIATRISTS, SOCIOLOGISTS, CRIMINOLOGISTS, STUDENTS AND THE LAY READER WITH AN INTEREST IN CLINICAL TREATMENT, INTERPERSONAL PSYCHOANALYSIS, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, GENDER ROLES, DISSOCIATION AND AGGRESSION.

THE BOOK *IDENTITY ISSUES: LITERARY AND LINGUISTIC LANDSCAPES* IS A COLLECTION OF ESSAYS, SET OUT TO EXPLORE THE NOTION OF IDENTITY AS A CONSTANTLY RELEVANT, VERY COMPLEX, MULTI-FACETED PHENOMENON. UNDERSTANDING IDENTITY IN A VERY BROAD SENSE, THE AUTHORS APPROACH IT FROM VARIOUS ANGLES, HIGHLIGHTING ITS VARIOUS ASPECTS. THE FIRST SECTION INCLUDES LITERARY EXPLORATIONS THAT DISCUSS IDENTITY ISSUES OF CLASS, RACE, NATION AND HISTORY, AS DEPICTED IN SEVERAL WORKS OF, MOSTLY, CONTEMPORARY ANGLO-AMERICAN LITERATURE. THE SECOND SECTION BRINGS VARIOUS LINGUISTIC STUDIES OF IDENTITY, STARTING WITH THE USUAL SOCIOLINGUISTIC ISSUES, BUT ALSO INCLUDING A RANGE OF OTHER RESEARCH ROUTES, WHICH DRAW UPON INSIGHTS FROM PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIOLOGY, HISTORICAL LINGUISTICS, COGNITIVE LINGUISTICS, LEXICOLOGY, FUNCTIONAL GRAMMAR, AND APPLIED LINGUISTICS. THE BOOK ADDRESSES A BROAD ACADEMIC AUDIENCE. DUE TO ITS WIDE SCOPE, BOTH IN TOPICS COVERED AND IN VARIED THEORETICAL APPROACHES,

IT IS NOT ONLY AIMED TOWARDS LITERARY SCHOLARS STUDYING MODERN ANGLO-AMERICAN LITERATURE, NOR ONLY AT SOCIOLINGUISTS INTERESTED IN LANGUAGE IDENTITY, BUT AT NUMEROUS ACADEMICS, AS WELL AS UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS, WHO ARE INTERESTED IN SOME OF THE DISCIPLINES THAT PROVIDED THE FRAMEWORK FOR VARIOUS ARTICLES (LITERARY STUDIES, SOCIOLOGY, COGNITIVE LINGUISTICS, LEXICOLOGY, FUNCTIONAL GRAMMAR, ACADEMIC WRITING, AND ENGLISH TEACHING).
