THIS RELEVANT AND TIMELY TEXT ADDRESSES THE SIGNIFICANT DEARTH OF RESEARCH BY EXPLORING THE TREATMENT OF DISABILITY IN CANADIAN LITERATURE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE. ENGAGING AND HIGHLY ACCESSIBLE, THIS TEXT WILL ASSIST TEACHERS, TEACHER EDUCATORS, AND TEACHER CANDIDATES IN FINDING AND USING BOOKS ABOUT CHARACTERS WHERE DISABILITY IS A PART OF THEIR CHARACTERIZATION, SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF CURRICULA THAT REFLECT CRITICAL LITERACY AND SOCIAL JUSTICE ISSUES.
